DIRECTIONS FROM FRANCISCO SÁ CARNEIRO AIRPORT (PORTO) TO I3S BY SUBWAY

You can take the line E (purple; direction: Trindade) at the Airport station. Destination station: Trindade; at this station you have to change to line D (yellow; direction: Hospital São João). Final destination station: Pólo Universitário and then walk for around 5min (250meters)

DIRECTIONS FROM FRANCISCO SÁ CARNEIRO AIRPORT (PORTO) TO FEP BY SUBWAY

To reach FEP from the airport you can take by public transport is by metro, line E (purple; direction: Trindade). You should then change at Trindade station to line D (yellow; direction: Hospital de São João). Final destination station: Pólo Universitário and then walk for around 10min (500meters).
